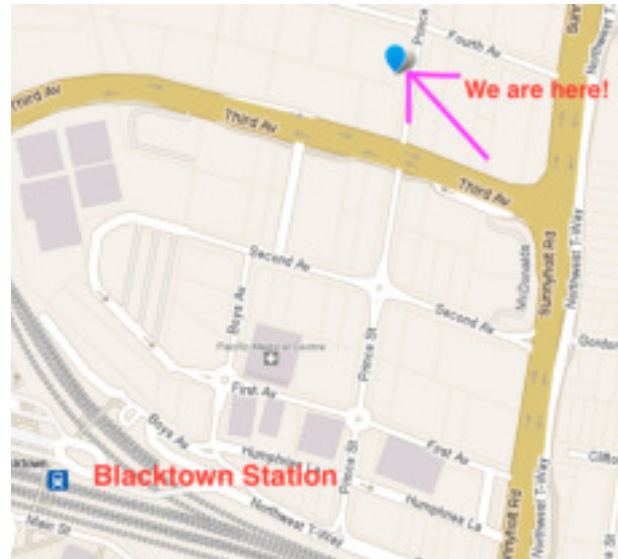
Who are We?
